Based on report of seomoz service, there are many pages with different GET parameters, but displaying the same meta title.			
These parameters are <i>order_type</i> , <i>sort_by</i> , <i>category_id</i> etc.			
It is needed to wrap them to <i>nofollow</i> instruction or correctly handle them displaying the respective page title.
